The meeting of the US Table Captains will be held in conjunction with this Zaf. It is scheduled for Friday morning, June 8, 2007 beginning at 8:00am. Coordination has begun with our National Captain, Ursa Major, to hold this meeting to a limited amount of time since there is not a lot to discuss. If all goes well, we will do our best to adjourn the meeting around 10:30am – this will allow for other activities to take place in the company of our Captives (Sooks).

In 2007, the entire state of Virginia and the nation celebrate the 400th Anniversary of the establishment of the first English speaking colony in the new world at Jamestown, VA. This Zaf will be held in conjunction with Norfolk's annual Harborfest weekend and Norfolk's tribute to this anniversary celebration. Due to the anniversary activities, this Harborfest will be the host to the largest floatilla of Tall Ships at one location since the OpSail 2000 Harborfest. Already, the City of Norfolk has commitments from 14 of the world's Tall Ships and, if all goes well, there could be as many as 20 – it will be some show!!!
