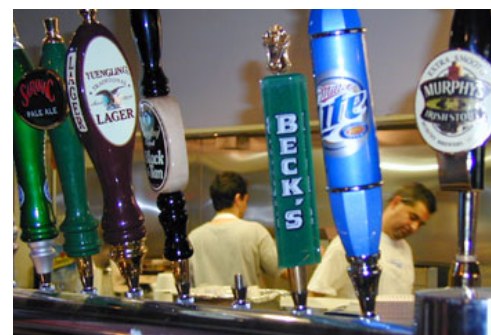

All food is purchased fresh daily, and ranges from \$1.25 to \$7.95. Fresh Calamari is the signature dish and has been voted the best in New York.
